BILL SUMMARY

Senate bill 149 creates the nonreverting Behavioral Health Facilities Fund to provide grants to assist counties and municipalities plan, purchase, renovate, or construct regional behavioral health facilities to provide treatment throughout New Mexico.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The bill appropriates \$160,800,000 from the general fund to the Health Care Authority Department for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of the Behavioral Health Facilities fund Act in FY25 and subsequent fiscal years.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

This bill does not impact the General Services Department (GSD) since the Fund will be administered by the Health Care Authority Department. Upon request, GSD will support the Health Care Authority Department with developing criteria and evaluating grant request for the purchase, renovation or construction of behavioral health facilities.
