BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

This bill amends the Legislative Lottery Tuition Scholarship Act.

- It defines full-time as enrolled in thirty or more credits per year for four-year state educational institution and twenty-four credits for students enrolled at a community college.
- It adds three summer semesters to the terms eligible for tuition scholarship funding, with summer enrollment required to be at least 3 credits and no more than 9. Students can only use the tuition scholarship if they do not need summer enrollment to maintain scholarship eligibility.
- It removes all references to legacy students.
- It removes credit hour limits to the semester prior to graduation.
- Students with disabilities may have their definition of "full time" adjusted to as low as 6 credits during a semester and 3 during a summer term.
- Dual credit courses do not apply to the credit hour cap for the tuition scholarship.

The reporting basis the Higher Education Department uses to estimate the next year's maximum distribution will be based on the annual increase in the higher education price index for the mountain region.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Removing credits earned through dual credit will greatly assist students who enroll at NMSU. We currently have over 200 dual credit students on the NMSU-Las Cruces campus. Many of them will exceed the 160-credit limit before they reach graduation. This will allow them to use the tuition scholarship until their graduation.
