SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis:</u> SB272 requires twelve named executive agencies and certain other types of public bodies, in the course of collecting demographic data, to collect voluntary self-identification information pertaining to sexual orientation and gender identity; requires reports to the Legislature; requires data be made available to the public as allowable by law; requires protection of personally identifying information and limits uses of data.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SB272 will necessitate the Aging and Long-Term Services Department (ALTSD) to change all automated and manual intake forms, internal tracking mechanisms and stakeholder information. It is estimated that this will cost \$10,000 in contractor fees and a 1/2 of one FTE position for the first year of the requirement. A level of effort quote is needed to determine how many hours this project will require.

SB272 will further necessitate ALTSD to engage in internal and external training and to produce updated training materials. It is estimated that this will require $\frac{1}{2}$ of one FTE position for the first year of the requirement. A full time FTE for updates and training is estimated at \$72,670.

There will be a fiscal impact for all providers engaged in contracts with ALTSD who collect information on behalf of ALTSD.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Gathering voluntary sexual orientation and gender identity data will increase quality of services provided to individuals served by ALTSD by allowing ALTSD to measure and track outcomes.

With the signing of Executive Order 2021-048 ("Directing Executive Departments to Collect

Voluntary Self-Identification Information Pertaining to Sexual Orientation and Gender Identity"),¹ ALTSD has already begun to collect such data. ALTSD's Aging & Disability Resource Center (ADRC) collects such data when older adults, persons with disabilities, and caregivers reach out to the ADRC to seek services and resources.
