BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

House Commerce and Economic Development Committee amendment to HB40 makes the following changes to HB40:

- Changes the definition of "covered facility" to include a group of interconnected public buildings or commercial places of public amusement that are located on a single premises.
- Adds "using visitor data that is tracked by that department" to refer to the method the Tourism department will use to track the number of visitors received by the facility each year.
- Adds "rest areas" to the definition of "public building".
- Adds the requirement that facilities that have a family or gender-neutral bathroom shall maintain at least one universal adult changing station.
- Adds that a universal adult changing station is not required in a covered facility if the installation would threaten or destroy the historic significance of a historic property.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The proposed amendment to HB40 bill will have no fiscal implication on the Facilities Management Division of the General Services Department.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The amendment to HB40 will impact public assembly facilities that receive at least two thousand five hundred (2,500) visitors per year, as measured by the Tourism department. Therefore, the amendment will have no performance or administrative impact on the General Services Department.
