### **SECTION III: NARRATIVE**

#### **BILL SUMMARY**

<u>Synopsis</u>: The original bill would (1) impose a civil penalty for the intentional unlawful disclosure of "sensitive personal information" by a state employee unless the disclosure falls under an enumerated exception.

The amended bill revises a previous exception (Section 3(E)) concerning disclosure of such information when made to or by the court in a judicial proceeding or made in a court record. The amended bill expands this exception to add disclosure of such information when made by or to an administrative tribunal during an administrative proceeding or made in an administrative tribunal record.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The amended bill slightly reduces liability as the amended exception to the unlawful disclosure of "sensitive personal information," Section 3(E), expands the previous disclosure exception to not only include allowing disclosure made by or to a court in the course of a judicial proceeding or made in a court record, but also in the course of an administrative tribunal proceeding or in an administrative tribunal record. The broader exception would slightly reduce liability because more state agencies and state employees would be subject to an exception of the unlawful disclosure, which would mean fewer violations. However, "administrative tribunal" should be defined to avoid any ambiguity.
