Short Title: Definitions of Tires and Vehicle Size

Description: This bill amends Section 66-3-1001.1 NMSA 1978 to update the definition of Off-Highway Vehicles. This bill amends tire type and vehicle weights and removes references to engine displacement. These changes will allow more modern machines to fall under the OHV definition than current statute allows.

Effective Date: July 1, 2025.
