### **BILL SUMMARY**

SB 486 proposes an act relating to government reorganization to create the Child Safety and Welfare Services Authority to be governed by a board of regents. and, transferring money, property, contracts and statutory references for the Children, Youth and Families Department (CYFD) to the Child Safety and Welfare Services Authority. The purpose of the authority is to:

- Provide an independent, accredited state agency to administer the State's child welfare and juvenile justice programs
- Cooperate and collaborate with other state agencies and institutions, judicial agencies and courts, school districts and local governments to establish a child safety and welfare system.

The board of regents will consist of 8 members and shall:

- Approve the mission, goals and objectives, and policies and procedures
- Appoint a state superintendent to compensated at the same rate as a cabinet secretary
- Approve the proposed and operating budget
- Approve rules
- Select the accrediting agency that accredits the authority

The authority consists of the following:

Office of the state superintendent

- Chief counsel and other attorneys
- Quality assurance bureau
- Tribal affairs

Administrative services division

- Budget bureau
- Human resources bureau
- Information technology bureau
