RELATED TO CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONTACT; ELIMINATING THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE NON-CONSENSUAL TOUCHING BE TO AN UNCLOTHED INTIMATE PART.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 30-9-12 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1975, Chapter 109, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"30-9-12. CRIMINAL SEXUAL CONTACT.--

A. Criminal sexual contact is the unlawful and intentional touching of or application of force, without consent, SJC→HJC→with the intent to arouse or gratify sexual desire, HJC←SJC SJC→with the intent to arouse or gratify sexual desire or to intrude upon the bodily integrity or personal safety of the victim or for any other unlawful purpose←SJC to the SJC→HJC→clothed or←HJC←SJC SJC→clothed or←SJC SJC→HJC→[unclothed]←HJC HJC HJC→unclothed←HJC←SJC SJC→SJC→[unclothed]←SJC SJC→unclothed←SJC intimate parts of another who has reached [his eighteenth birthday] eighteen years of age, or intentionally causing another who has reached [his eighteenth birthday] eighteen years of age to touch one's HJC→clothed or unclothed←HJC intimate parts.

HJC→B. Criminal sexual contact does not include touching by a psychotherapist on [his] a patient that is:

- (1) inadvertent;
- (2) casual social contact not intended to be sexual in nature; or
- (3) generally recognized by mental health

 professionals as being a legitimate element of

- (1) by the use of force or coercion that
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results in personal injury to the victim;
