20	<u>A.</u> Any member of the legislature [ <del>of the State of</del>
21	New Mexico] may resign [his] <u>the member's</u> office by filing a
22	written statement of [ <del>such</del> ] resignation with the secretary of
23	state [ <del>of New Mexico</del> ], and upon the filing of [ <del>such</del> ] <u>the</u>
24	resignation, the office of senator or representative filled by
25	the person [ <del>so</del> ] resigning shall become vacant.
