AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO PROVIDE OR
CONTRACT FOR HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS AND ACQUIRED IMMUNE
DEFICIENCY SYNDROME SERVICES AND PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. The following amounts are appropriated from the
general fund to the department of health for expenditure in
fiscal year 1997 to provide or contract for the following
purposes:

(1) five hundred forty-two thousand dollars
(\$542,000) for persons with human immunodeficiency virus for
services to include emergency housing support, emotional and
practical support and client services, complementary and Native
American therapies, transportation, home care and services for

women and children;

(2) one hundred twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$128,000) to contract with New Mexico state institutions of higher education that have medical and health sciences resources for a collaborative approach to statewide rural education and recruitment of professionals, paraprofessionals and mental health care providers, including substance abuse counselors; and

(3) six hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$630,000) for human immunodeficiency virus prevention services and programs, including targeted outreach and one-on-one peer-based outreach and youth behavior modification efforts, media resources and behavior change support groups.

B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
