16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
19	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
20	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
21	Act in an amount not exceeding one million two hundred ten
22	thousand dollars ($\$1, 210, 000$) when the state department of
23	public education certifies the need for the issuance of the
24	bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance
25	and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical

1 manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the 2 project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. 3 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps 4 necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as 5 6 amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the state department of public education in the 7 following amounts for the following purposes: 8 9 (1)seven hundred fifty thousand dollars 10 (\$750,000) to continue planning, designing, constructing and

equipping Pojoaque high school located in Santa Fe county;

(2) two hundred ten thousand dollars (\$210,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a track and football complex for Pojoaque valley schools located in Santa Fe county; and

(3) two hundred fifty thousand (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a central administration office and boardroom for Pojoaque valley schools located in Santa Fe county.

B. If the state department of public education has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Subsection A of this section at the end of fiscal year 1999
