AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY FOR A FLOUR MILL IN CLOVIS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the economic development department for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of contracting for a feasibility study to establish a flour mill in Clovis located in Curry county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
