AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COMMEMORATIVE ACTIVITIES HONORING NEW MEXICO'S "FIRST FAMILIES"; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1.
