17	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
18	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding eighty-five thousand
21	dollars (\$85,000) when the local government division of the
22	department of finance and administration certifies the need for
23	the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
24	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most
25	expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the

1 board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to 2 contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance 3 shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply 4 with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and 7 administration for the purpose of purchasing a new ambulance and 8 9 equipment for the Columbus volunteer fire department located in 10 Luna county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax 11 12 If the local government division of the bonding fund. 13 department of finance and administration has not certified the 14 need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 15 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void. 16

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
