17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
20	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
21	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding
22	Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
23	authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 and 3 of this
24	act. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and
25	sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner

possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 and 3 of this act.

B. The agencies named in Sections 2 and 3 of this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.

C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.

D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2 and 3 of this act at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.

Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PROPERTY CONTROL DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION--PURPOSES.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the property control division of the general services department that the need exists for the issuance of the

bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the property control division of the general services department for the following purposes:

A. one million one hundred eighty-two thousand seven hundred dollars (\$1,182,700) to make electrical repairs and upgrades at the Santa Fe headquarters complex located in Santa Fe county and the district 5 headquarters located in Bernalillo county; and

B. five hundred fifty-two thousand six hundred 10 dollars (\$552,600) to renovate the heating, ventilation and air conditioning system at the Santa Fe headquarters complex located 11 12 in Santa Fe county.

SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC Section 3. SAFETY--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the department of public safety that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, five hundred forty-three thousand four hundred dollars (\$543,400) is appropriated to the department of public safety for the purpose of purchasing equipment for the emergency management complex located in Santa Fe county.

EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public Section 4. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
