18	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSPURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED
19	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDSThe state board of finance may issue
20	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
21	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million seven
22	hundred thousand dollars ($\$1,700,000$) when the board of regents
23	of New Mexico highlands university certifies the need for the
24	issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall
25	schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most

expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for the purpose of completing phase one of the deferred maintenance projects at New Mexico highlands university located in San Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax If the board of regents of New Mexico highlands bonding fund. university has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
