19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding three hundred
21	thousand dollars ($\$300,000$) when the board of regents of New

23	of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 5 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 6 bonds are appropriated to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for the purpose of renovating the 7 natatorium at New Mexico highlands university located in San 8 Miguel county. 9 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining 10 at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the board of regents of New Mexico highlands 11 12 university has not certified the need for the issuance of the 13 bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided 14 in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
