19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding four hundred sixty
21	thousand dollars (\$460,000) when the state highway and
22	transportation department certifies the need for the issuance of
23	the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the
24	issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
25	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the

1 project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable 2 The state board of finance shall further take the 3 time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue 4 5 Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the 6 bonds are appropriated to the state highway and transportation department for the purpose of funding phase I of the Parkwood 7 storm drainage project in the city of Moriarty located in 8 9 Torrance county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 10 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the state highway and 11 12 transportation department has not certified the need for the 13 issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the 14 authorization provided in this section shall be void. 15 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public

peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
