AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE YOUTH PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES IN QUESTA IN TAOS COUNTY; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the local government division of the department of finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 to develop, provide and promote programs and activities for youth and their families in Questa in Taos county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
