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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
17	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
18	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in
19 ••	compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the
20 21	amounts authorized for purposes specified in Sections 2 through 4 of this act. The state board
21 22	of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and
23	economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed
24	sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a
25	reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to
	comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the
	bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in Sections 2 through 4 of this act.

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1	B. The agencies named in Sections 2 through 4 of this act shall certify to the
2	state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized
3	in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act.
4	C. If the specified agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the
5	bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this act shall be void.
6	D. Unless otherwise specified in this act, any unexpended or unencumbered
7	balance remaining from the proceeds of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to Sections 2
8	through 4 of this act at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding
9 10	fund.
10	Section 2. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSSTATE HIGHWAY AND
12	TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENTPURPOSESPursuant to the provisions of Section 1
13	of this act, upon certification by the state highway and transportation department that the need
14	exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the state
15	highway and transportation department for the following purposes:
16	A. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to landscape and improve
17	Central avenue from San Mateo boulevard to Girard avenue at Triangle park in Albuquerque
18	located in Bernalillo county;
19	B. two hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$220,000) to construct landscaping
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21	and a trail along Gibson boulevard in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county;
22	C. one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design and construct a pedestrian
23	overpass on Gibson boulevard in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county; and
24	D. five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to complete the reconstruction of
25	Yale boulevard in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county.
	Section 3. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSDEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
	ADMINISTRATIONPURPOSESPursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon


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1 certification by the local government division of the department of finance and administration 2 that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are appropriated to the 3 local government division of the department of finance and administration for the following 4 purposes: 5 A. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to design and build a little league 6 park for the Lobo little league in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county; 7 B. one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to design and construct 8 Rinconada Point park in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county; and 9 C. two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to design and construct 10 improvements to Zia park in Albuquerque located in Bernalillo county. 11 Section 4. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 12 13 EDUCATION--PURPOSE.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon 14 certification by the state department of public education that the need exists for the issuance of 15 the bonds, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated to the state department of 16 public education for the purpose of purchasing equipment and furniture and planning, 17 designing and constructing improvements to the Whittier school building in Albuquerque 18 located in Bernalillo county. 19 Section 5.
