Section 1. TRANSFER AUTHORITY--GENERAL FUND OPERATING RESERVE. --Upon a determination that fiscal year 1995 revenues and transfers to the general fund, including the transfer authorized by Laws 1995, Chapter 30, Section 8, are not sufficient to meet fiscal year 1995 appropriations, the governor, with state board of finance approval, is authorized to transfer sixty-five million five hundred thousand dollars (\$65,500,000) from the unencumbered balance in the general fund operating reserve for expenditure to meet that fiscal year's obligations.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
