The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New 5 6 Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of providing a solid waste transfer station at Twin Lakes located in McKinley 7 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the 8 county. 9 end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax 10 bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of Indian affairs has 11 not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end 12 of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section 13 shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
