1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for the purpose of planning, 7 designing or constructing an office complex to house social 8 9 service programs for the Pueblo Pintado community near Cuba 10 located in McKinley county. Any unexpended or unencumbered 11 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to 12 the severance tax bonding fund. If the New Mexico office of 13 Indian affairs has not certified the need for the issuance of 14 the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization 15 provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
