WHEREAS, teachers should also promote random acts of kindness week, by encouraging schoolchildren to participate in random acts of kindness by taking time out of recess to help clean up the playground, inviting a new student to share their lunches, holding a canned food drive or simply encouraging others around them to commit one random act of kindness each day;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 12 through 18, 1996 be proclaimed as "random acts of kindness week" and encourage all New Mexicans to treat one another with compassion and caring, as well as encourage schoolchildren to participate in all manner of random acts of kindness; and
