A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THAT THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC EDUCATION

ENCOURAGE ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO BECOME ELIGIBLE

MEDICAID PROVIDERS AND THAT IT PROVIDE A DISTRICT-BY-DISTRICT

ASSESSMENT OF THE REASONS WHY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS ARE UNABLE

TO BECOME ELIGIBLE PROVIDERS UNDER THE STATE MEDICAID PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the federal government has determined that public school districts are able to receive medicaid reimbursement for services currently being provided by the state; and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need for additional healthrelated services to be provided by public schools; and

WHEREAS, the state legislature requested that the state department of public education, with the assistance of an appointed task force, conduct a study of medicaid eligibility in

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public schools; and

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WHEREAS, the state department of public education and the appointed task force recommended to the state legislature that all public school districts become eligible to receive medicaid funds by the 1996-1997 school year; and

WHEREAS, approximately one-third of public school districts are currently eligible to receive medicaid funds; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive assessment of why more public school districts have not become medicaid providers needs to be conducted:

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state board of education encourage all public school districts to become eligible medicaid providers by the year 2000; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public education provide a district-by-district assessment of the specific reasons why public school districts are unable to become eligible medicaid providers, as well as a detailed plan to encourage more public school districts to become medicaid providers; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public education present to the legislative education study committee a list of public school districts that have agreed to become medicaid providers; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state department of public

education report its findings of the assessment to the legislative education study committee by November 1, 1996; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be sent to the superintendent of public instruction and the director of the legislative education study committee for appropriate di stri buti on.
