WHEREAS, the corrections department's current system of data collection with regard to the inmate population is antiquated and inadequate; and

WHEREAS, a modern system of data collection is necessary for the corrections department to efficiently manage the inmate population, accurately project future inmate population levels and maintain a demographic profile of the inmate population; and

WHEREAS, the ability to accurately estimate future inmate population levels is a necessary prerequisite for corrections department projections regarding future programming needs for

inmates; and

WHEREAS, an accurate estimate of future immate population growth is vital information for policymakers who seek to make informed decisions on a full range of sentencing options for inmates; and

WHEREAS, when future discussions of prison capital construction projects arise, the corrections department's ability to provide accurate inmate population projections and a demographic profile of the inmate population will assist policymakers seeking to make informed judgments regarding the size and classification type of new prison projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the corrections department explore means for improving its system of data collection with regard to the inmate population; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the corrections department prepare a written report concerning its efforts to improve its data collection system and make a formal presentation of that report to an interim legislative committee with jurisdiction over corrections issues no later than September 30, 1996; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of corrections.
