## A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF CREATING A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CERTIFICATION PROGRAM FOR USE BY THE NEW MEXICO COALITION AGAINST DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

WHEREAS, in 1994 the New Mexico legislature, through a memorial sponsored by the interim legislative health and human services committee, recognized the New Mexico coalition against domestic violence as experts in the field of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, domestic violence is a separate and distinct problem area from other social, marital, mental health and developmental problems, and domestic violence counseling has expanded exponentially in New Mexico within the last twenty years, paralleling the rise of domestic violence in our nation;

and

WHEREAS, domestic violence counseling has evolved in a nontraditional fashion through peer counseling, support and self-help services provided by feminists, battered women and domestic violence survivors who have extensive experience with those issues and who often do not have formal training in the field; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure that properly qualified and trained personnel are providing services to victims of domestic violence, a specialized certification program should be developed, for use by the New Mexico coalition against domestic violence, by the human services department in cooperation with the regulation and licensing department and the New Mexico coalition against domestic violence;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it ask the human services department, together with the regulation and licensing department and the New Mexico coalition against domestic violence, to study the feasibility of creating a specialized certification program for use by the New Mexico coalition against domestic violence to establish a standard for certification as a domestic violence counselor; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the human services department present the results of its study to the interim legislative health and human services committee no later than October 1,
