A JOINT MEMORIAL

URGING THE STUDY OF EXPANDED EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TO MEET GROWING RURAL HEALTH NEEDS.

WHEREAS, the past twenty years have seen tremendous growth in New Mexico's emergency medical services system; and

WHEREAS, more lives are being saved in emergency situations today than ever before in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, these impressive results are due in large part to the effective training and dedication of citizens and community volunteers who give thousands of hours in training and services annually; and

WHEREAS, presently there are New Mexico communities in which the nearest emergency medical service is the only source of health care in proximity; and

WHEREAS, recognizing this situation, federally funded national pilot projects in Red River and the Moreno Valley, designed to increase the capabilities of emergency medical service providers, are producing excellent results; and

WHEREAS, these expanded emergency medical service pilot programs offer the potential for an otherwise unavailable cadre of community medical providers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the department of health study the feasibility of expanded emergency medical services in rural medically underserved communities throughout the state as one major asset to be included in any managed care plans for the area; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of health utilize the expertise of the emergency medical services bureau and the emergency medical services medical direction committee, as well as representatives of any statewide ambulance organizations, a private, nonprofit ambulance service, a proprietary ambulance service, both a large urban hospital and a small community hospital or medical clinic, representatives of the managed health care industry and a representative of the department of emergency medicine of the university of New Mexico school of medicine; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that both the insurance division and the motor transportation division of the state corporation

commission also participate in the study; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of health report its findings to the interim legislative health and human services committee at its October 1996 meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be sent to the department of health for its distribution to all appropriate parties.
