A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE MOTOR VEHICLE DIVISION NOT TO DISCLOSE SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBERS ON DRIVER'S LICENSES AND INSTRUCTION PERMITS.

WHEREAS, social security numbers are currently printed on motor vehicle driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses and instruction permits; and

WHEREAS, social security numbers can be used to obtain credit in the form of cash, goods and services; and

WHEREAS, the ready availability of a social security number on a driver's license and instruction permit increases the opportunity for fraudulent use of credit by affording unscrupulous persons access to information used to verify identity for credit purposes; and

WHEREAS, social security numbers are not required by law to appear on driver's licenses and instruction permits; and

WHEREAS, there are reports of consumer fraud occurring in New Mexico based on improper use of a consumer's social security number obtained from normal review of a consumer's driver's license for check cashing purposes; and

WHEREAS, a number of other states have reportedly changed their practice and now delete social security numbers from driver's licenses precisely because of consumer fraud problems; and

WHEREAS, the motor vehicle division of the department of taxation and revenue apparently has the authority under current law to change by regulation the current practice and not disclose social security numbers on driver's licenses and instruction permits; and

WHEREAS, prohibiting the disclosure of social security numbers on driver's licenses and instruction permits does not prohibit the motor vehicle division from requesting and maintaining records of social security numbers for administrative and law enforcement purposes or from incorporating social security numbers in driver's licenses and instruction permits in a magnetic or other coded form that is not readable by the general public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the motor vehicle division of the taxation and revenue department be requested not to disclose social security numbers on driver's licenses, commercial

driver's licenses and instruction permits; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the governor, the secretary of taxation and revenue and the director of the motor vehicle division.
