13	ASSISTANCE AND TELEPHONE SERVICE FOR PARENTS WHO RECEIVE
14	ASSISTANCE FROM THE AID TO FAMILIES WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN

17	WHEREAS, the republican contract with America includes
18	conversion of specific categories of assistance for the
19	disadvantaged to block grants to the states; and
20	WHEREAS, the intent of block grants is, among other things,
21	to remove restrictions on the use of money and to provide the
22	state more flexibility; and
23	WHEREAS, both current welfare programs and those proposed
24	by the contract with America envision more able-bodied
25	individuals actively seeking, gaining and retaining employment;

WHEREAS, unemployed individuals often do not have the means to afford telephone service and therefore cannot easily seek or be available for work or employment-related interviews; and

WHEREAS, relocation and telephone expenses are difficult for indigent families to pay, but are frequently necessary and are not allowed by current federal restrictions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the human services department be requested to allow money from block grants to be used for relocation assistance and telephone services for parents who receive assistance from the aid to families with dependent children program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the secretary of human services.

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
