SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 17

A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 9, SECTION 10 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PERMIT COUNTIES THE USE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR THE ACQUISITION OF OPEN SPACE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 9, Section 10 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"No county shall borrow money except for the following purposes:

- A. erecting, remodeling and making additions to necessary public buildings;
- B. constructing or repairing public roads and bridges;
- C. constructing or acquiring a system for supplying water, including the acquisition of water and water rights,

necessary real estate or rights of way and easements;

- D. constructing or acquiring a sewer system, including the necessary real estate or rights of way and easements:
- E. constructing an airport or sanitary landfill, including the necessary real estate; $[\frac{\partial r}{\partial r}]$
- F. the purchase of books and other library resources for libraries in the county; $\underline{\text{or}}$

G. the acquisition of open space.

In such cases, indebtedness shall be incurred only after the proposition to create such debt has been submitted to the registered voters of the county and approved by a majority of those voting thereon. No bonds issued for such purpose shall run for more than fifty years. Provided, however, that no money derived from general obligation bonds issued and sold hereunder shall be used for maintaining existing buildings and, if so, such bonds shall be invalid."

Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at the next general election or at any special election prior to that date which may be called for that purpose.
