17	Section 1. AUTHORIZATION OF PROJECTSPursuant to the

Section 2. AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE BONDS--APPROPRIATIONS.--Pursuant to the provisions of the New Mexico Finance Authority Act, the New Mexico finance authority may issue and sell revenue bonds payable from the public project revolving fund in an amount not to exceed ten million three hundred fifty-seven thousand dollars (\$10, 357, 000), the proceeds of which are appropriated in the following amounts to the following agencies for the following purposes:

A. six million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$6,800,000) to the taxation and revenue department to purchase and install the taxation and revenue information management system;

B. two hundred twenty thousand seven hundred dollars (\$220,700) to the general services department to purchase and install a requisition processing system;

C. four hundred ten thousand five hundred dollars (\$410,500) to the public defender department to purchase and install office automation and case tracking systems;

D. seven hundred eighteen thousand dollars (\$718,000) to the state treasurer to develop, purchase and install the treasurer's warrant account reconciliation accounting system;

E. three hundred seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$307,800) to the regulation and licensing department to purchase and install computer system improvements;

F. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to the office of the state engineer to purchase equipment to conduct a comprehensive information system pilot project for water rights and hydrological studies;

G. two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to the human services department to purchase and install an information system for the income support division system;

H. six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) to the department of health to develop, purchase and install a system for the community provider payment project; and

Ι. six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to the corrections department to purchase and install the inmate management information system.

Section 3. CERTIFICATION. -- The New Mexico finance authority shall require periodic certification from the agencies identified in Section 2 of this act and from the department of finance and administration that the approved project is on schedule and that all funds have been properly expended for the project. A copy of the certification and all supporting documentation shall be submitted to the legislative finance committee.

EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public Section 4. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
