A JOINT MEMORIAL

WHEREAS, she has recently choreographed Verdi's *La Forza*Del Destino for Placido Domingo and the New York metropolitan

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opera, and she is scheduled to choreograph Bizet's Carmen for the metropolitan opera this fall for the second time; and

WHEREAS, she received the governor's award for excellence in the field of dance, the classical dance award from the institute of Puerto Rico and the golden key to the city of Miami, and she has served on peer panels of the national endowment for the arts and the arts division of the New Mexico office of cultural affairs; and

WHEREAS. Maria Benitez has thrilled audiences all over the world with her unique style of flamenco and impassioned entertainment, and in so doing, has exposed the world to her native southwestern heritage and culture;

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that its congratulations, recognition and commendations be expressed and conveyed to Maria Benitez upon her nomination for the national medal of arts and for her tireless celebration of New Mexico's heritage and cultural roots; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to Maria and Cecilio Benitez and to the teatro flamenco.

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
