AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DWI GRANT COUNCIL; CHANGING THE MEMBERSHIP OF
THE DWI GRANT COUNCIL; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE LOCAL DWI GRANT
PROGRAM ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 11-6A-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993,
Chapter 65, Section 4) is amended to read:

"11-6A-4. DWI GRANT COUNCIL--MEMBERSHIP--DUTIES.--

A. The "DWI grant council" is created and shall
consist of [~~the president of the New Mexico municipal league,~~
~~the president of the New Mexico association of counties,~~ the
~~secretary of health or the secretary's designee,~~ the secretary
~~of finance and administration or the secretary's designee,~~ the
~~chief of the traffic safety bureau of the state highway and~~
~~transportation department and two representatives of local~~

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1 ~~governing bodies who shall be appointed by the governor so as to~~
2 ~~provide geographic diversity]:~~

3 (1) a representative of the New Mexico
4 municipal league, to be selected by the board of directors of
5 the New Mexico municipal league;

6 (2) a representative of the New Mexico
7 association of counties, to be selected by the board of
8 directors of the New Mexico association of counties;

9 (3) the secretary of health or his designee;

10 (4) the secretary of finance and administration
11 or his designee;

12 (5) the chief of the traffic safety bureau of
13 the state highway and transportation department;

14 (6) a representative of the public education
15 system, to be selected by the state board of education;

16 (7) a representative of the state judiciary, to
17 be selected by the supreme court; and

18 (8) two representatives of local governing
19 bodies, who shall be appointed by the governor; provided that
20 the governor shall ensure geographical diversity when making his
21 appointments.

22 B. Appointed members shall be appointed to a two-
23 year term. In the event of a vacancy, the governor shall
24 appoint a member for the remainder of the term.

25 C. The council shall meet as necessary to receive

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1 applications, consider grant requests and award DWI grants
2 pursuant to the Local DWI Grant Program Act. All actions of the
3 council require the affirmative vote of a majority of the
4 members of the council.

5 D. Members of the council shall be reimbursed for
6 per diem and mileage in accordance with the Per Diem and Mileage
7 Act. "

8 Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. --The effective date of the
9 provisions of this act is July 1, 1997.
