AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COMMUNITY-BASED PROGRAMMING RELATED  
TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT AND PREVENTION FOR NATIVE  
AMERICANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One hundred fifty thousand  
dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the  
purpose of funding northwest New Mexico fighting back, a  
community-based organization that seeks to reduce the demand for  
alcohol and drugs through community organizing and public  
awareness in McKinley, Cibola and San Juan counties. Any  
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
