AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSING BOARDS; EXTENDING THE SUNSET DATES ON
CERTAIN BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 60-13-58 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
Chapter 194, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"60-13-58. TERMINATION OF AGENCY LIFE-- DELAYED REPEAL. --
The construction industries commission and division and its
trade bureaus are terminated on July 1, ~~[1997]~~ 2005 pursuant to
the Sunset Act. The construction industries commission and
division and its trade bureaus shall continue to operate
according to the provisions of Chapter 60, Article 13 NMSA 1978
and Chapter 70, Article 5 NMSA 1978 until July 1, ~~[1998]~~ 2006.
Effective July 1, ~~[1998]~~ 2006, Chapter 60, Article 13 NMSA 1978
and Chapter 70, Article 5 NMSA 1978 are repealed. "
