AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING THE EDUCATIONAL RETIREMENT ACT
TO ALLOW PROVISIONAL MEMBERS TO ACQUIRE EARNED SERVICE CREDIT
FOR CERTAIN PERIODS OF EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-11-17 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
Chapter 16, Section 141, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-11-17. PROVISIONAL MEMBERSHIP. - -

A. A provisional member shall be covered by the
provisions of the Educational Retirement Act but shall have the
option to exempt himself from its coverage. A provisional
member exempting himself from the provisions of the Educational
Retirement Act shall not be entitled to the benefits or coverage
under any other state retirement program except as otherwise
provided in this section. This section shall not affect any

1 rights a provisional member may have under the provisions of the
2 federal Social Security Act. This option to exempt must be
3 exercised within one year of employment according to the
4 regulations adopted by the board. Any provisional member
5 exempting himself pursuant to this section shall be entitled to
6 a refund of any contributions made pursuant to the Educational
7 Retirement Act prior to the exercise of the exemption.

8 B. A provisional member not exempt from the coverage
9 of the Educational Retirement Act shall have the right to earned
10 service-credit for periods of employment subsequent to July 1,
11 1957 and prior to July 1, 1961, provided that all contributions
12 at the rates in effect during that period of employment are
13 paid. If a provisional member chooses to make the contributions
14 for that period, the local administrative unit employing a
15 member during that period shall pay the employer's contribution
16 at the rate in effect during that period of employment.
17 Contributions prior to July 1, 1961 by both the provisional
18 member and the local administrative unit shall bear interest at
19 the rate of three percent a year from July 1, 1961 until paid.

20 C. A provisional member exempt from the coverage of
21 the provisions of the Educational Retirement Act shall have the
22 right to revoke the exemption at any time; however, within the
23 first two weeks following the beginning of each school year,
24 such provisional member shall be informed by the local
25 administrative unit in writing of his right to revoke the

1 exemption and shall sign a statement to the effect that he does
2 or does not wish to revoke the exemption. A copy of such
3 statement shall be kept by the local administrative unit in the
4 personnel file of the provisional member. Any provisional
5 member who revokes his exemption from coverage shall have the
6 right to acquire earned service-credit for periods of employment
7 during which the exemption or exemptions were in force, under
8 the following conditions:

9 (1) both the member and the administrative unit
10 contributions, at the rates in effect during the periods of
11 employment and applied to the earnings of the member during such
12 periods, shall be paid to the fund, together with interest, at a
13 rate equal to the actuarial assumption rate by the board;

14 (2) member and administrative unit
15 contributions, together with interest, may both be paid by the
16 member; or

17 (3) if the member tenders payment of his
18 contributions, together with interest, the local administrative
19 unit by whom he was employed may, but shall not be obligated to,
20 pay the administrative unit contributions, together with
21 interest; and

22 (4) the right of a member to acquire earned
23 service-credit in accordance with this subsection shall expire
24 on June 30, 2001.

25 D. A provisional member employed by the board, the

1 department of education, the New Mexico school for the deaf, the
2 northern New Mexico state school, the New Mexico school for the
3 visually handicapped, the New Mexico girls' school, the New
4 Mexico boys' school or the Los Lunas mental hospital shall have
5 the option of qualifying for coverage under either the
6 Educational Retirement Act or the public employees retirement
7 association of New Mexico. This option shall be exercised by
8 filing a written election with both the educational retirement
9 director and the ~~[director]~~ executive secretary of the public
10 employees retirement association of New Mexico. This election
11 shall be made within six months after employment and shall be
12 irrevocable regardless of subsequent employment or reemployment
13 in any administrative unit enumerated in this subsection. Until
14 this election is made, the provisional member shall be covered
15 and shall be required to make contributions under the
16 Educational Retirement Act. "
