10 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO MAKE THE SALARIES OF CHILDREN, YOUTH
11 AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT SOCIAL WORKERS MORE COMPETITIVE WITH
12 THOSE OF SURROUNDING STATES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- One million three hundred
16 eighteen thousand seven hundred fifty-two dollars (\$1,318,752)
17 is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and
18 families department for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and
19 1998 for the purpose of providing a one-time seven percent pay
20 increase to the department's social workers to make those
21 salaries more competitive with those of surrounding states. Any
22 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
23 fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

24 Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
25 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
