AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO FUND THE

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars
(\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the
purpose of providing general operational funds to the Pecos
valley medical center ambulance service in the village of Pecos
located in San Miguel county. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to
the general fund.
