AN ACT

RELATING TO FOOD PRODUCTS; EXEMPTING CERTAIN GAME MEAT PRODUCTS
FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE NEW MEXICO FOOD ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the New Mexico Food Act is
enacted to read:

" NEW MATERIAL DONATED GAME MEAT PRODUCTS-- EXEMPTION. --

A. The provisions of the New Mexico Food Act shall
not apply to wild game meat products that have been donated by
hunters, taken to a commercial meat processor for preparation
and delivery to charitable, religious or other nonprofit
organizations and distributed for human consumption at no charge
to homeless or other indigent individuals.

B. For purposes of this section, "wild game" means
deer, elk, antelope, caribou, ibex, oryx and Barbary sheep.

C. If a charitable, religious or other nonprofit organization prepares or serves wild game pursuant to Subsection A of this section, the organization shall post at the entrance to the dining area a sign bearing the following message: "The wild game served at this facility has not been subject to state or federal inspection."
