AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A PILOT PROJECT IN TAOS COUNTY TO ASSIST IN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BY INCREASING EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES THROUGH RECRUITING NEW BUSINESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred twelve thousand dollars (\$512,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the economic development department for expenditure in fiscal years 1998 and 1999 for the purpose of establishing a pilot program to recruit new businesses to Taos county to promote economic development by increasing employment opportunities. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the general fund.
