AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR ADDITIONAL JUVENILE CORRECTIONS BEDS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$3,900,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 to acquire, install, equip and furnish a total of three fifty-bed secure modulars to house high-risk youthful offenders at the New Mexico boys' school, the youth diagnostic and development center or any other appropriate juvenile facility operated by the department. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

of the general services department certifies the need for the ssuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable The state board of finance shall further take the time. appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the capital program fund to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a one-hundred bed care, rehabilitation and treatment facility for male adjudicated delinquents committed to the children, youth and families department in the middle Rio Grande corridor. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2000 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. If the property control division has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1999, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.".

- 3. Renumber the succeeding sections accordingly.
- 4. On page 1, lines 15 and 16, strike "Three million nine hundred thousand dollars (\$3,900,000)" and insert in lieu thereof "Four million four hundred thousand dollars (\$4,400,000)".
- 5. On page 1, line 19, strike "three" and insert in lieu thereof "two".
