AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DWI OVERSIGHT TASK FORCE; ADDING THE PRESIDENT OF MOTHERS AGAINST DRUNK DRIVING AS AN ADVISORY MEMBER TO THE TASK FORCE; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 2-12-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1993, Chapter 65, Section 16) is amended to read:

"2-12-7. MEMBERSHIP--APPOINTMENT--VACANCIES. --

A. The DWI oversight task force shall be composed of six legislative members, six public members and ~~[thirteen]~~ fourteen advisory members from the executive and judicial branches of government.

B. Three members of the house of representatives shall be appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives and three members of the senate shall be

1 appointed by the ~~committees'~~ committee of the senate or, if the
2 senate appointments are made in the interim, by the president
3 pro tempore of the senate after consultation with and the
4 agreement of a majority of the members of the [~~committee's~~]
5 committees' committee. Members shall be appointed from each
6 house so as to give the two major political parties in each
7 house the same proportional representation on the task force as
8 prevails in each house; however, in no event shall either party
9 have less than one member from each house on the task force.
10 Vacancies on the task force shall be filled by appointment in
11 the same manner as the original appointments.

12 C. Three public members shall be appointed to the
13 task force by the speaker of the house of representatives and
14 three public members shall be appointed by the president pro
15 tempore of the senate so as to represent the state's ethnic and
16 geographic diversity. The public members of the task force
17 shall be paid per diem and mileage in accordance with the
18 provisions of the Per Diem and Mileage Act plus reimbursement
19 for reasonable actual expenses.

20 D. Additionally, the task force shall include the
21 following advisory members:

- 22 (1) the secretary of finance and administration
23 or the secretary's designee;
- 24 (2) the attorney general or his designee;
- 25 (3) the president of the district judges

16 (12) one district attorney appointed by the
17 president of the district ~~[attorney's]~~ attorneys association;

19 (13) the secretary of taxation and revenue or
20 the secretary's designee; and

21 (14) the president of mothers against drunk
22 driving or the president's designee.

23 E. The speaker of the house of representatives and
24 the president pro tempore of the senate shall each designate one
25 co-chairman of the task force. "
