AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO DEVELOP A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM
AND FACILITY BASED ON NATIVE AMERICAN TECHNIQUES OF TRADITIONAL
HEALING IN BERNALILLO COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Three hundred six thousand
three hundred dollars (\$306,300) is appropriated from the
general fund to the New Mexico office of Indian affairs for
expenditure in fiscal year 1998 for the purpose of contracting
to develop a domestic violence prevention and counseling program
based on Native American traditional healing practices and
concepts and a facility in which to house it in Albuquerque
located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to
the general fund.
