AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING A SECTION OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE PERTAINING TO STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 22-12-2.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1986, Chapter 33, Section 27, as amended) is amended to read:

"22-12-2.1. INTERSCHOLASTIC EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES--STUDENT PARTICIPATION. --

A student shall have a 2.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent, either cumulatively or for the grading period immediately preceding participation, in order to be eligible to participate in any <u>interscholastic</u> extracurricular activity. For purposes of this section, "grading period" is a period of time not less than six weeks.

The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to special education students placed in class C and class D programs.

- No student shall be absent from school for school-sponsored <u>interscholastic</u> extracurricular activities in excess of fifteen days per semester, and no class may be missed in excess of fifteen times per semester.
- The provisions of Subsections A and B of this **C**. section apply [to all] only to interscholastic extracurricular activities.
- D. The state superintendent may issue a waiver relating to the number of absences for participation in any state or national competition. The state superintendent shall develop a procedure for petitioning cumulative provision eligibility cases, similar to other eligibility situations.
- E. Student standards for participation in <u>interscholastic</u> extracurricular activities shall be applied beginning with a student's [second semester of grade eight] academic record in grade nine."
