AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAYS; REQUIRING THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO
PAY TO THE COUNTIES A PER-MILE AMOUNT FOR EACH MILE OF STATE
ROAD OR HIGHWAY CERTIFIED FOR TURNOVER TO THE COUNTIES FOR
COUNTY MAINTENANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 67-3-40 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1919,
Chapter 99, Section 13) is amended to read:

"67-3-40. CONTROL OF STATE HIGHWAYS-- MAINTENANCE. --

A. The state highway commission shall have full
control over all roads designated by the [~~said~~] commission as
state highways or created as state highways by acts of the
legislature [~~and~~]. The costs of maintenance thereof shall be
paid by the state, provided, that if at any time the [~~moneys~~]
money in the state road fund available for improvement or

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1 maintenance of all such state highways in the state shall not be
2 sufficient for such purposes, the state highway commission shall
3 certify to the respective boards of county commissioners the
4 certain sections of such highways in the ~~[several]~~ counties,
5 proportionately to such deficiency, which shall be improved and
6 maintained wholly by the respective counties until sufficient
7 funds ~~[shall be]~~ are provided in the state road fund to enable
8 the state to take over and maintain them as state highways,
9 subject to payment as provided in Subsection B of this section.

10 B. Upon determination by the state highway
11 commission to certify turnover of some sections of state
12 highways to the boards of county commissioners for county
13 maintenance pursuant to Subsection A of this section, the
14 commission shall calculate a per-mile amount pursuant to this
15 subsection and shall pay each county an amount equal to the per-
16 mile amount multiplied by the miles of state highway turned over
17 to the county. The per-mile amount for any year in which such a
18 turnover is proposed shall be the amount calculated by dividing
19 the total budget of the state highway and transportation
20 department for the prior fiscal year by the total public road
21 mileage maintained by the department."
