AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE
CONFIDENTIALITY OF PROPRIETARY INFORMATION OBTAINED BY THE
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 9-15-10 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983,
Chapter 297, Section 10, as amended) is amended to read:

"9-15-10. ORGANIZATIONAL UNITS OF DEPARTMENT-- POWERS AND
DUTIES SPECIFIED BY LAW- ACCESS TO INFORMATION.-- Those
organizational units of the department and the officers of those
units specified by law shall have all of the powers and duties
enumerated in the specific laws involved. However, the carrying
out of those powers and duties shall be subject to the direction
and supervision of the secretary, and he shall retain the final
decision-making authority and responsibility for the

1 administration of any such laws as provided in Subsection B of
2 Section 9-15-6 NMSA 1978. The department shall have access to
3 all records, data and information of other state departments,
4 agencies and institutions, including its own organizational
5 units, not specifically held confidential by law. Any
6 information obtained by the department that is deemed by the
7 secretary to be proprietary technical or business information
8 shall be held in confidence. Proprietary technical or business
9 information shall not be deemed a public record pursuant to the
10 Public Records Act or be open to inspection pursuant to Section
11 14-2-1 NMSA 1978. The department shall take such steps as are
12 necessary to safeguard the confidentiality of the information."
