AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; CHANGING THE PURPOSE OF
GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS IN LEA AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES;
MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
ADMINISTRATION--CHANGE IN PURPOSE-- APPROPRIATION. --The balance
of the appropriation from the general fund to the department of
finance and administration pursuant to Subsection CCC of Section
24 of Chapter 222 of Laws 1995 for the purpose of site
preparation or transportation costs to relocate a historical
building at the museum complex in the city of Lovington in Lea
county shall not be expended for its original purpose but is
appropriated to the local government division of the department
of finance and administration for the purpose of site

4 Section 2. GENERAL FUND--DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND
5 ADMINISTRATION--CHANGE IN PURPOSE--APPROPRIATION.--The balance
6 of the appropriation from the general fund to the department of
7 finance and administration pursuant to Subsection S of Section
8 21 of Chapter 4 of Laws 1996 (1st S.S.) for the purpose of
9 installing a parking lot or landscaping for the county extension
10 office building in Roosevelt county shall not be expended for
11 its original purpose but is appropriated to the local government
12 division of the department of finance and administration to
13 replace window coverings and paint throughout the courthouse
14 buildings in Roosevelt county.

15 Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public
16 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
