MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN
FOR ENTREPRENEURIAL MENTORSHIP AND BUSINESS TRAINING PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Fifty thousand dollars
(\$50,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
commission on the status of women for expenditure in fiscal year
1998 for entrepreneurial mentorship and business training
programs, including national and international marketing
strategies for promotion of products and services. Any
unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of
fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.
