AN ACT

**MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR HOMELESS OR
MENTALLY ILL VETERANS AND NON-VETERANS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the mental health division of the department of health for expenditure in fiscal years 1997 and 1998 for the purpose of providing or contracting for referral, job placement, housing services or supportive social services for homeless or mentally ill veterans and non-veterans. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1998 shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take place immediately.
